Goat Rearing & Dairy Training

Three nos. of 2 days goat rearing and dairy training has organized at village Nauda under Gunupur block in Rayagada district from 20.04.2021 to 27.04.2021 where 80 no. of ST men and women had participated for 2 hours and another has been organized from 18.05.2021 to 20.05.2021 where 80 no. of ST and SC men & women had participated from villages of Dambosara, Ghanatri, Ambabadi and Srirampur. The resource person explained the benefit of use of goat and cow milk and dung. And 4 nos. of 3 days Desi goat rearing and dairy training to help the people of the Munda, Titimir & Vimpurguda area have been organized from 05.08.2021 to 28.08.2021 where 160 nos. of men and women had participated for 3 hours consisting 40 members in each batch. The experienced resource person Mr. Debaraj Acharja had explained the use of goat and cow milk, dung and urine for their economic development and sustainable income. This area is covered by natural plants where the animals are getting green foods from the jungle. So many people are anxious to keep these domestic animals for their livelihood because before these camps they do not know the benefit of goat milk.

Bio-Manure Production.

Four nos. of 5 days bio-manure training have been organized at Village Nauda under Gunupur Block in Rayagada district where 110 nos. of ST men and women have participated consisting 25 members in each batch from the villages of Nauda, Burtunguda, Chaitanguda, Kuruguda, Talmunda, sambaraguda and Narsinmunda. All batch training had organized at Village Nauda from 10.09.2021 to 15.11.2021 consecutively where all the participants have gained knowledge to produce bio manure easily in using locally available leaves, cow and goat dung. First batch had started from 10.09.2021 to 14.09.2021 and 2nd from 15.09.2021 to 19.09.2021 and 3rd from



21.09.2021 to 25.09.2021 and another rest two batches started from 22.09.2021 to 30.09.2021 and 11.10.2021 to 20.10.2021. All trainings had imparted by Mr. Debaraj Acharya, Retd. Assit. Director, IMAGE, Siripur, Bhubaneswar. And two nos. of training programme had organized at Saraswatipur under Pipili block in Puri district where 40 nos. of men and women had participated to produce bio-manure, 30 in each batch.

Vermin Compost Training Programme.

Two nos. of 14 days vermin compost production training had organized in village Munda in Titimiri GP in Gunupur block in Rayagada district from 10.11.2021 to 23.11.2021 and from 24.11.2021 to 07.12.2021 where 100 men and women had participated 50 nos. in each batch from villages Titimiri Bandhaguda, Ankreli, Munda and Bhimparuguda. The training was started for 2 hours daily by Mr. Debaraj Acharya.

Mushroom Cultivation Training Programme.

Four nos. of 12 days mushroom cultivation training have been organized in Dambosara village under Gunupur block in Rayagada district from 05.10.2021 to 16.10.2021 and from 17.10.2021 to 28.10.2021 and from 29.10.2021 to 09.11.2021 and 12.11.2021 to 23.11.2021 involving 120 men and women from the villages of Dambosara, Ghanantri, Mering, Ambabadi and Subarnapur 40 members in each batch for three hours daily by the experienced resource person Mr. Chittaranjan Routray. And another two nos. of training have been organized in the village Saraswatipur from 28.11.2021 to 09.12.2021 and from 12.12.2021 to 23.12.2021 involving 80 nos. men and women 40 nos. in each batch by Mr. Chittaranjan Routray experienced person in the field.

Organic Farming Training

Two nos. of 10 days organic farming training have been organized at village Soura bikrapur under Dambosara G.p in Gunupur block where 60 nos. of men and women had participated 40 nos. in each batch from the villages. The training had organized from 20.07.2021 to 19.07.2021 and from 25.07.2021 to 03.08.2021 an experienced resource person Mr. Manoranjan Mishra. The farmers learnt about the



benefit of the organic farming. How this method is protecting human body and also soil health they knew about it and they applied this in their own lands.

Solar PV Lighting Training

Two nos. of Solar PV Lighting training have been organized in Saraswatipur Village under Pipili Block in Puri district involving 180 nos. of youths 60 nos in each batch from 05.01.2022 to 04.02.2022 youths from the villages of Kothasahi, Sanagaon, Saraswatipur, Chhanahara, Choraoda and Nalihana for three hours daily training. The training was imparted by an experienced and qualified master trainer Mr Satrugna Behera two batches daily to educate the youths.

Carpentry Training

One day carpentry training for 4 days had been organized in Dambosara village under Gunupur block in Rayagada district from 02.01.2022 to 05.01.2022 where 290 nos. of person had participated in dividing 45 per batch. The training was imparted by Mr. Susanta Kumar Sabar. And another one day training programme for the youths of Saraswatipur, Chhanaghar and Kothasahi for 2 days had organized from 15.01.2022 to 16.01.2022 by Mr. Babrubahan Jena where 200 nos of youths had participated.

Tailoring and Bag Making Training

A tailoring and bag making training had organised at village Nauda under Gunupur block in Rayadgada district from 05.08.2021 to 30.09.2022 in the premises of madhiguda training Hall where 30 nos. of ST women had successfully taken training for 6 months by an experienced MCM Mrs. Nabaja Sabar. After successful completion of training the trainees of Nauda and Buringuda village have established a Bag production centre in this area and they supply it to the near by Market area Gunupur.

Mason Training

A 4 months mason training programme had started for the welfare of the local unskilled labour to enhance their income at Saraswatipur under Pipili block by Mr. Babrubahan Jena an experienced master trainer where 30 nos. of men had taken



training. The trainees from nearby villages had participated in this programme. All the 30 nos. of trainees have successfully completed the training.

of male and female persons have participated .The resource persons had explained about the management of natural resources i.e soil health ,water, land & air how we will able to get benefits in utilizing these. For example if the rain water harvesting structures would have been constructed in these areas we will get water in summer season to produce the vegetables, fishery and agriculture products which will help to create employment opportunities in these locality otherwise the rain water is going to river as usual . The camp started from 28.04.2021 to 06.06.2021 consecutively in between 3-9 days interval. The participants awared about the good health of soil for better production in an organic process to get good human health.


